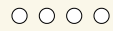

RideConnect - new transportation option for Madison County residents!

- We have launched a new transportation option for our residents called RideConnect. This is in partnership with Catholic Social Services of the Miami Valley.
- This service is for riders who fall through the cracks, people who do not qualify for Medicaid or have transportation through Medicare.
- RideConnect provides free rides for these riders and is dependent on volunteer drivers in the county.
- Currently we have one volunteer driver in Madison County who was willing to allow this service to be launched in our county.
- If you know someone who needs a ride please have them call Lindsay Scites at 740-812-4748 to determine if they are eligible for this service.

CCMEP (Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program)

This is a state-run workforce development initiative in Ohio that supports low-income youth and young adults aged 14 to 24 by helping them build career paths, obtain education, or work credentials, and secure employment.

In Madison County to be eligible income needs to be 200% of the federal poverty guideline.

CCMEP provides many different services. One of which is paying for driving classes. Currently it is only for teens.

CCMEP also offers:

- Work experiences (paid/unpaid internships, job shadowing, summer jobs, OJT)
- Education supports (tutoring, GED, postsecondary preparation, training)
- Supportive services (transportation, childcare, housing help, uniforms/tools)
- Career planning & job placement
- Financial literacy & entrepreneurial training.

- Our vehicles are accessible to accommodate mobility devices.
- Advanced reservation is requested.
- Same Day and advanced reservations are scheduled as availability allows.
- To schedule a ride on our Transit, call 740-335-9628.
- \$1.00 one way within the city of London
- \$1.50 one way outside London but within Madison County.
- \$3.00 one way to Fayette County
- Out of county trips are \$2.50 per mile
